Disabled/Displaced Scholarship: Student has a MET or IEP from an Arizona public school (preschool and K-12) **or** Student has a 504 plan from an Arizona public school (K – 12th grade) **or** Student was placed at one time in the Arizona foster care system (K-12th grade).
